1.	Inform the Master of the proximity of ice.			
2.	Inform the engine room of the proximity of ice.			
3.	Inform the crew of the proximity to ice.			
4.	Close all watertight doors.			
5.	Moderate speed as appropriate in the conditions.			
6.	Increase the frequency of sounding tanks and bilges.			
7.	Monitor ice advisory service broadcasts.			
8.	Transmit danger messages in accordance with SOLAS.			
9.	Inform crew regarding restrictions to open decks covered with ice
