(www.CMTS.gov) On July 23, 2020, the CMTS Coordinating Board approved the establishment of a COVID-19 Working Group (C19 WG). (https://www.cmts.gov/topics) Member agencies concurred that the COVID-19 Pandemic was impacting the Marine Transportation System (MTS) and stakeholders in a myriad of ways and that there could be benefit to enhanced interagency discussion and communication.

This Federal guidance and reference catalog was developed by the C19 WG in response to a recommendation stemming from COVID-19-related industry calls held by the Maritime Administration. The Federal guidance catalog is one of a number of CMTS actions in an aggressive work plan to respond to several challenges related to the pandemic.
